In your exaltation, O Lord, you were given the name that is above every name; we pray in your name for those who are poor, those who are hungry, and those who are hurting in any way. Give them your grace. Lord in your mercy

We also pray, in your name O Lord, for those who are sick (*please add your intercessions*) Give them the gift of healing, strength, and life. Lord in your mercy

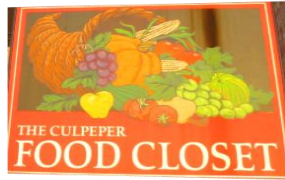

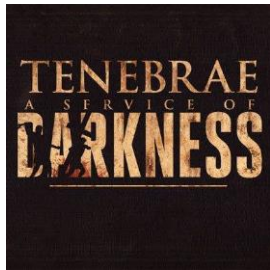

Experience the Dark before the Light. Tenebrae Service will be held on April 18, 2019 at 7:30 PM. The Tenebrae service includes the gradual extinguishing of candles and other lights in the church until only a single candle, considered a symbol of our Lord, remains. Toward the end of the service this candle is hidden, typifying the apparent victory of the forces of evil. At the very end, a loud noise is made, symbolizing the earthquake at the time of the resurrection (Matthew 28:2), the hidden candle is restored to its place, and by its light all depart in silence.
